Harriet Wilson to give this group some identification, and she submitted the name True Love, which was received by all. The installation service for Rev.

Willie Williams, Jr., was held on December 8, 2006, and conducted by the Freedman Association, Rev. Joshua J. Davis, President. True Love was greeted by a full house to help celebrate our newly elected pastor. True Love responded with a feast second to none to say "welcome" to Rev. Williams and "thanks" to all our guests.

CURRENT NEEDS
